CHANGES TO SCHOOL CALENDAR 2019-20

As stated in this policy, a member of the school's Senior Leadership Team will contact parents/carers should there be a significant or a recurrent breach of the school's uniform policy. Where there is a significant breach, parents/carers will be asked to pick up their child, remedy the breach, and return with the child to school as soon as possible. Where this does not take place, the pupil will remain indoors during all break and lunchtimes on the first day of the breach and all subsequent days until the breach is remedied. We thank all parents and carers in advance for their invaluable support in ensuring that our school uniform policy is always strictly adhered to.
