Stonehenge

In Class 6 we partnered with Class 5 for a dramatic recap of the changes that took place from the Stone Age to the Bronze Age. We then used drama to recreate the Stonehenge monument in class, and a group of explorers looked at five possible explanations for the use of the site.



Children acted out the processes of using the site for tracking the seasons and the movements of the sun and the moon, for holding parties and festivals, for worship, for treating the sick, and for burying the dead.

They then worked on solving the history mystery by looking at the evidence for each use and deciding which one they thought was most likely.
