Foundation Subjects

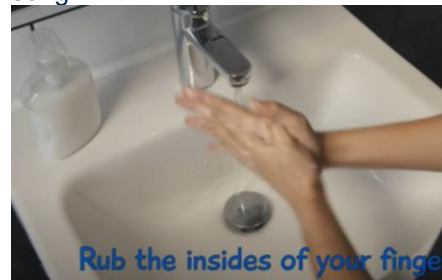
PSHE- Hygiene, washing hands.

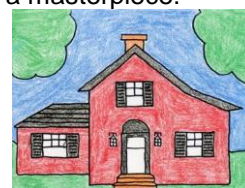
