### History Project 'The Maya Civilisation'

Research the Maya Civilisation and create an exciting project including:

- A cover page
- A map showing where the Ancient Maya Civilisation lived
- Information on the Maya creation story
- A timeline of events
- Research and find out some facts about the Maya Civilisation. Create a mind map (spider diagram) with all your new knowledge.
- Find out the names of some Maya Gods. Write them down in a list and try drawing one of them.
- Find out about the Maya number system.
- Follow a Maya Hot Chocolate recipe-make it with an adult and...Enjoy!



#### Art and Craft

##### Ideas

**-Design and make a Maya mask.**



Masks played a central role in Maya culture. They were made for a variety of occasions and purposes.

**-Design and/ or make a Maya Headdress**

The more important the person, the bigger the headdress. Make yourself important! Use card to make the basic shape. Use feathers, paint, sequins and beads to decorate.

**-Draw or make a Maya Hous**

### Geography Project 'Water'

Design an eye-catching front cover for your project on Water, then complete as many of these activities as you can:

**Keep a daily water diary for a week.** Write down every time you use water and what for. At the end of the week write a short evaluation. Are you surprised by how much water you use? Were there some days you used more water than others?

**-Research and draw a diagram of the Water Cycle**

**-Make some water fact cards**

**-Research and write a short newspaper report about a flooding event in the UK**

**-Research and write a short newspaper report about a flooding event not in the UK**

**- Changing states investigation** (Ask an adults permission first) Fill a bottle of water and put it in the freezer. What happens to the water after a number of hours? What do you think will happen if you now leave this bottle out of the freezer? Write a short description of your findings and draw a diagram.

**-Find out the definitions of these key words and make a mini glossary for your project: freezing, melting, evaporation, condensation, precipitation, transpiration, flooding** (you can decorate your glossary once finished.)



Think about the layout of each page you produce – make each one different if you can.
