## THIS WEEK IS HOLY WEEK

Holy Week began on Palm Sunday. During Holy Week in school, we have been recalling the events leading up to Jesus' death whilst also looking forward to His Resurrection, which we celebrate this coming Sunday. This Friday is



Good Friday, when Christians commemorate Jesus' suffering and death on the cross. It is traditionally a day of sorrow, penance, and fasting. We wish all our families the peace, holiness, hope and joy of the Easter season.

#### FIRST HOLY COMMUNION UPDATE

As you are aware, the Sacramental Programme has not taken place so far this year. However, when the time comes and it is once again safe to meet together to prepare your child to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion, we will need to know the number of children who will be taking part in the programme. A letter should have reached the relevant parents this week, inviting you to enroll your child on the next Parish Sacramental Programme.

We do not know, as yet, when or how many meetings will be held or the dates of church celebrations. We will let you know as soon as we can. If you wish your child to receive these sacraments and have not received a letter inviting you to enroll then please phone the school office as soon as possible.

## IF A PUPIL DISPLAYS COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

It is important to remember that parents and carers <u>must</u> keep children at home (or come to school immediately and collect them) if they display ANY of the symptoms of COVID-19. The household must then self-isolate and arrange for a PCR test. The child may return to school if the test result is negative.

# **REVISED PICK UP ARRANGEMENTS FOR Y2 PUPILS**

From now on, parents of pupils in Year 2 should come to the main gate on Sutcliffe Avenue to pick up their child at the end of the school day. The staff car park will no longer be open to parents of Year 2 pupils at the end of each day. Parents should not walk through the staff car park from now on. Please stay away from staff cars and ensure that your children do too. Please be respectful of the church lawn and gardens. Please also be considerate and safe in your parking near school. Please do not block neighbours' drive ways or the entrance or exit to the staff car parks. Many thanks in advance for your full cooperation.

## **ANYTHING TO STAFF ON THE GATE**

Please do not ask staff on duty at school entrances at the start of the day to pass any of your child's items on. Staff have been instructed not to receive any such items. Please plan ahead and give these to your child instead. Many thanks in advance.

## SUMMER UNIFORM RULES AFTER EASTER

From Monday 12th April when we return to school, and as an alternative to winter uniform, pupils may wear summer uniform. Summer uniform may be worn until the October half-term holidays. For girls, summer uniform consists of blue and white gingham dress. Girls may also wear white tights or black, white or grey socks as part of summer uniform. Boys' summer uniform consists of dark grey trousers or shorts, light blue polo shirt and plain navy school sweatshirt (preferably with the school logo and no other logo allowed).

#### NOTIFYING SCHOOL OF POSITIVE TEST RESULTS FOR COVID-19 OVER THE EASTER HOLIDAYS

Until 3.30pm on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> April, if your child has been in school and subsequently tests positive for COVID-19, parents are asked to notify school via an email to comments@st-

richards.manchester.sch.uk . The school will then identify possible close contacts of your child in school and – if necessary - advise self-isolation for other pupils and staff (as your child may have been infectious whilst in school). This advice to self-isolate will be via a ParentMail text. The above email address will not be monitored after 3.30pm on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> April. During this period, school staff will not be on-call at all times. After 3.30pm on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> April, the school must not be contacted. Instead, parents and carers must contact NHS Test and Trace. If this happens, school do not need to be informed about an absence until the first day of the new term (Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2021).
