# A MESSAGE TO YEAR 6 PARENTS ABOUT THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

A message from Father Michael Deas, our Deanery Coordinator for the Sacrament of Confirmation:

'The Diocese of Salford has changed the age at which children receive the Sacrament of Confirmation to when they are in Y8. So your child is due to be Confirmed in Easter 2023. Confirmation is the next sacramental milestone after First Holy Communion, when a person 'confirms' their faith and is strengthened by the Holy Spirit. All the preparation for this Sacrament will be organised on a local deanery level, or in your local parish. At this time, we are just contacting you to make you aware and so that you can register your interest. So, if you and your child are interested in taking part in the preparation and receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation, please fill out and submit the attached Google Form and your parish priest will contact you with more information in the future.'

# IF A PUPIL DISPLAYS COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

It is important to remember that parents and carers <u>must</u> keep children at home (or come to school immediately and collect them) if they display ANY of the symptoms of COVID-19. The household must then self-isolate and arrange for a PCR test (a Lateral Flow Device test is not sufficient). Your child may return to school if the PCR test result is negative.

#### UNITED NATIONS DAY OF CULTURAL DIVERSITY

# PLEASE DO NOT DO A 'DRIVE-BY' DROP OFF

I want to remind all our parents who drop off their children by car that 'drive-by drop-offs' are dangerous and we ask you not to do this, especially as it means stopping on zig-zag yellow lines outside school - which is against the law. Instead of attempting this and possibly endangering the safety of your own and other people's children, please give yourself plenty of time in the morning, park further away from school and walk the last few hundred metres. This is a much safer way to begin the school day and is part of the 'Park and Stride' approach that we should be adopting. Many thanks in advance for your support.
