CHRISTMAS CONCERTS ARE ON ... SO FAR

At the time of writing, Christmas Concerts for Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be going ahead as previously advertised on the newsletter. However, no one is certain of the trajectory that COVID-19 will take this winter. We remain hopeful that the concerts will proceed with a live audience of parents but - if additional safety measures are recommended or have to be put in place – please bear in mind that parental attendance at these concerts may have to be limited or even not allowed at all. If this were to be the case, the children would still put their performances on and we would make every effort for parents to be able to see a video-recorded version of the concerts.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME NEWS

Unfortunately, yesterday's planned Reconciliation Service with children from Class 9 and Class 10 receiving the Sacrament of Forgiveness at St Richard's Church for the first time had to be postponed. This has now been rearranged for Thursday 25th November. This evening, the second group of Year 4 children will receive Holy Communion for the first time in St Richard's Church at 6.30pm. COVID-19 UPDATE

It remains vitally important that parents do not send their child to school if their child has any symptoms of COVID-19, however mild. The main symptoms of COVID-19 are:

- a high temperature.
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If your child demonstrates any of the above symptoms whilst they are in school, you will be contacted and asked to come for them immediately and keep them off school at least until your child has had the result of a PCR test. Your child should stay at home and not have visitors (self-isolate) until you get the test result - they can only leave home to have the test.

AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

We currently have four different after-school sports clubs running, as well as a Computing Club, a Year 6 Singing Club and an Arts Club. We also provide both before and after-school Maths Tuition for some of our Year 6 pupils. Please continue to watch this space and look out for letters coming home as we re-establish and build back our excellent pre-pandemic after-school club provision.

OFSTED/CQC SEND INSPECTION OF MANCHESTER CITY COUNCIL LOCAL AREA ALL NEXT WEEK

Next week (from Monday 22nd November to Friday 26th November 2021), Manchester City Council's effectiveness in identifying, meeting the needs of and improving outcomes for children and young people who have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) will be inspected by Ofsted and the Care Quality Commission (CQC). The inspection will evaluate how effectively the local area:

- identifies the needs of children and young people with
- meets the needs of these children and young people so that their outcomes and chances of participating fully in society improve.

The views of children and young people with SEND, and the views of their parents and carers will be gathered during visits to a number of early years settings, schools, colleges and specialist services. These views are critical to the inspection process. During the inspection, Ofsted and CQC inspectors will be keen to speak to as many children and young people and their parents and carers as possible. There are several ways in which children, young people, parents and carers from our school can engage with the inspection process and contribute their views. The inspection will include a survey of parents and carers. The survey opened on Monday 15 November and will close at 11:59pm on Tuesday 23 November 2021.
