POSSIBLE TEACHER STRIKE ACTION

The National Education Union (NEU) announced on Monday 16th January that its ballot of teacher members in England has met the threshold required to commence industrial action. The NEU has announced national and regional action in England on the following dates which could possibly affect St Richard's. These dates are:

- Wednesday 1st February 2023
- Tuesday 28th February 2023
- Wednesday 15th March 2023
- Thursday 16th March 2023

Should the NEU decide to proceed with industrial action on these dates, we will let parents know (with as much notice as possible) whether this means St Richard's will have to close, will be able to stay fully open or may have to restrict attendance to certain groups of pupils on these dates.
