Our Science topic this half term has been on Electricity. As an introduction to the topic, we took part in an Electricity Day. First we learnt that humans are also conductors of electricity and created a human circuit. We made a number of circuits, using various components.



We also investigated the use of switches, conductors and insulators and practised drawing circuit diagrams using the correct symbols. Using our electrical knowledge, we then designed and made 'Night Lights' to take home after we had been photographed with our models.



This half term, our Art project has been exploring tie-dye. We researched its history and a tie-dye artist called Hugo Pineda. We trialed different tie-dye methods on paper towels and then applied our knowledge of wet-on-wet from our watercolouring topic last term.
