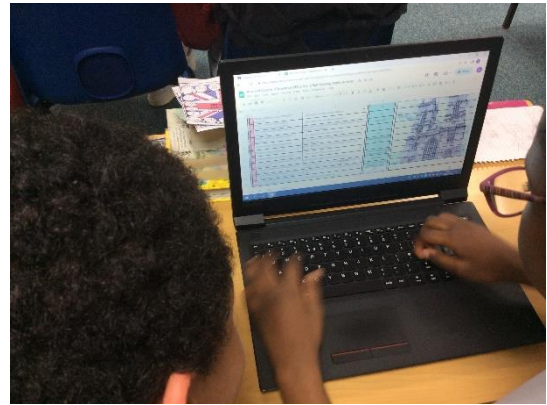




Class 11
