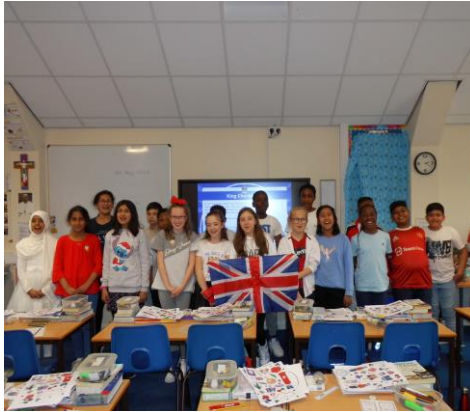




## Class 12
