



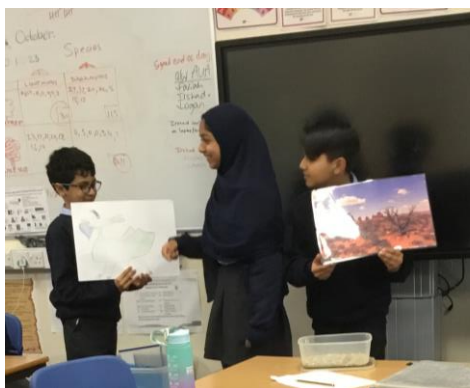
Class 12
