ST RICHARD'S RC PRIMARY GOVERNORS' INFORMATION & DUTIES – Reviewed November 2023

Introduction

In order to remain outstanding in our leadership and management (including governance) and to make best use of the valuable time of our governors and our staff in school, we undertook an internal review of our governance structures in Autumn 2019.

The principles which underpinned our internal review of governance:

- That Foundation governors should outnumber all other voting governors combined at committee and at full governing body meetings.
- That most of the hard work should be done at committee stage and ratified at full GB meetings.
- That there should be little need to repeat activity or items.
- That sub-committee membership should be distributed so that no one governor is asked to do too much (equitable distribution of responsibility and workload).

Outcomes:

- The Resources committee was re-named The Finance and Personnel committee. It meets at least once every term.
- A new Safeguarding, Health & Safety and Premises committee was created. It meets every term.
- Termly updates on Admissions are included in the HT's Report to governors. The full Governing Body (GB) has delegated day-to-day functions and decisions of the Admissions committee to the Headteacher (HT) Updated Admissions Policies will still be approved at full GB level.
- The Curriculum committee and the GB links meetings were merged in 2019 and we now have a termly meeting of governors and teaching staff in the school hall to find out about really important things happening in the curriculum at St Richard's. All the governors meet with their named link teacher/manager and then receive a termly curriculum overview/update. There is always a curriculum-focused presentation to end this meeting.
- In 2019 we introduced a simple and effective written format so that governors are able to evidence their activity and its impact at St Richard's. These written records are held in a file in school, accessible at any time by a governor.
- The three termly committees meet in the first half-term of Autumn, Spring and Summer and the full governing body meets in the second half-term (as late as possible).
- In the Autumn term there is an annual meeting of the Teachers' Pay Committee and the Headteacher's Performance Management Committee.
- Terms of Reference are in place and are reviewed on an annual basis by each committee
- If a committee is ever not quorate, other governors will be contacted to enable the meeting to proceed. Where this happens, they will only be recorded as attending that specific meeting.
