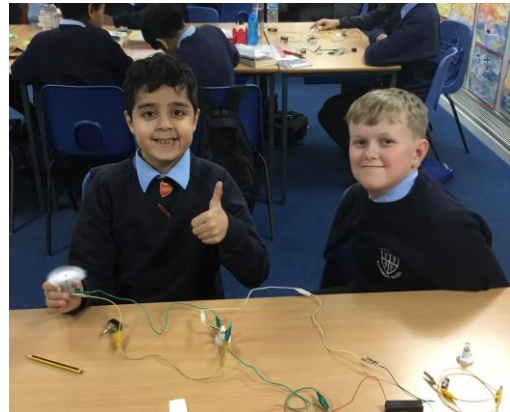




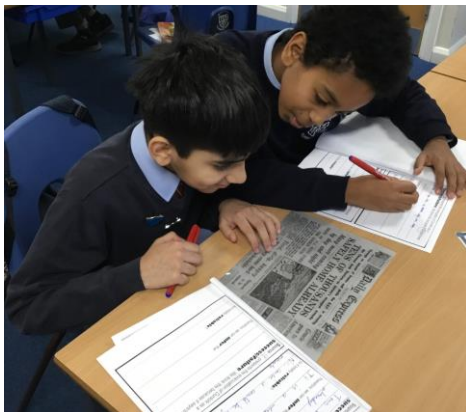
Class 13
