Dear Parents/Carers,

Please find below an overview of our Key Stage 2 SATs results at St Richard's this year.

Our Key Stage 2 SATs results were **AMAZING** this year and our Year 6 pupils and their teaching staff did us all proud with their consistent effort and application in achieving these **FANTASTIC** test results:

MATHEMATICS 93% - Meeting expectations with 47% High Attaining (the national average at expected this year was 73%)

READING 92% - Meeting expectations with 45% High Attaining (the national average at expected this year was 74%)

GPS 95% - Meeting expectations with 66% High Attaining (the national average at expected this year was 72%)

WRITING 80% - Meeting expectations with 15% High Attaining (the national average at expected this year was 72%)

Our Year 6 children meeting expectations in Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined is **75%**. This is a **GREAT** result, and is considerably higher than the national average this year which is 61%. 13% of our pupils achieved high attaining in all three subjects.

For the Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check there was no pass mark for this test, made up of 25 marks.

72% of our Year 4 pupils scored either 24 or 25, with over half at 57% scoring full marks. A superb achievement!

We thought that you would like to know that our School's Average Multiplication Tables Check Mark was **23.8**. The National Average Multiplication Tables Check Mark in 2022-23 was 20.2.

78% of the children in Year 1 achieved the pass mark in the Phonics screening check and again their teachers are very pleased with their progress.

I would like to thank all the class teachers, intervention teachers, teaching assistants and pupils for all their hard work and dedication in making these very pleasing whole-school results possible. And of course, the parents, for the continued support you give with your child's development and education.
