KEY STAGE TWO LEAGUE TABLE SUCCESS

Last week, the government published Key Stage 2 performance tables for all schools for last academic year. We are delighted to announce that, of the 166 schools who make up the table for Manchester local authority, St Richard's was:

FIRST for the average score in Maths. **SECOND** for the average score in Reading. **SEVENTH** for the percentage of pupils attaining the higher standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.

EIGHTH for the percentage of pupils attaining the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.

This is a **FANTASTIC** achievement and one which we are all very proud of. This has all been made possible by our hard-working and dedicated teachers and TAs. Mr Keyworth, Mrs Toal and our Year 6 teachers are especially pleased with the achievements of our pupils last year, and we also thank our parents for their continued support in their children's success.

WHEN YOUR CHILD IS POORLY

At St Richard's, we are in full agreement with current NHS advice that it is fine to send your child to school with a minor <u>cough</u> or <u>common cold</u>. However, if they have a high temperature, please keep them off school until it goes down. Children with <u>diarrhoea or vomiting</u> should stay away from school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for at least 2 days (48 hours).
