PRIORITISING PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

We all have a very important role to play in prioritizing pedestrian safety on the streets and pavements around our school. Parents should always use authorised crossing points and ensure that they have close supervision of their children when crossing roads. Drivers should drive considerately and park as far away from school as possible. Drivers must not block pavements or pedestrian walkways as this makes it more dangerous for pedestrians, who may be forced to walk in the road as a result. We have invited Traffic Enforcement Officers to visit school in the near future to monitor this.
