SUMMER READING CHALLENGE 2025 IN MANCHESTER

The theme for the Summer Reading Challenge 2025 is 'Story Garden'. It runs 1st July – 13th September 2025. Children need to go along to the public library to pick up their joining card and sign up for the Summer Reading Challenge. There is no charge to join in. If children are not already library members, they can join on the day. There are no charges for library membership and borrowing, and no fines for books returned late. Children complete the challenge when they have borrowed (and returned) 6 library books.

They can read any library book they choose (fact, fiction, poetry etc). They will receive their medal and a special bookmark in the library when they have finished the challenge. Certificates will be sent to primary schools in the autumn term for children who completed the challenge. Year 6 pupils (and any child not returning to a Manchester primary school) can ask for their certificate and medal in the library.
