CHANGE TO CLASS 1 EXIT ARRANGEMENTS AFTER HALF-TERM

When we return after half-term – and in order that there is less crowding at any one gate on Sutcliffe Avenue – the following change is being made: Children in Class 1 will be dismissed through the main gate (KS1 entrance) on Sutcliffe Avenue at 3.25pm. All other KS1 classes will remain unaffected (C2 will still be dismissed through the wide gate on Sutcliffe Avenue at 3.25pm, children in C3 will still be dismissed through the wide gate on Sutcliffe Avenue at 3.30pm and C4 will be dismissed through the main gate (KS1 entrance) on Sutcliffe Avenue at 3.30pm).
