THE THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT: GAUDETE SUNDAY

This coming Sunday (14th December) is the third Sunday of Advent and is known as Gaudete Sunday. This is a day of joyous celebration (Gaudete is Latin for 'rejoice'). Although it takes place during the serious season of Advent, Gaudete Sunday is a mid-point break and a chance to rejoice in the nearness of Jesus' return. This is when we light the pink candle on the Advent wreath. Rejoice and be happy everyone!



CHILDREN'S BOOK PROJECT

Before we break up for Christmas, every child at St Richard's will be able to choose two books to bring home to keep. This is due to our involvement, in the National Year of Reading 2026, with the Children's

APPLYING FOR A RECEPTION PLACE FOR SEPTEMBER 2026

If your child's date of birth is between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022 and they are due to start primary school in September 2026 and you live in Manchester then please follow this link to make an online application:

The application round for Reception 2026 school places is currently open and the deadline for submitting an on-time application is Thursday 15th January 2026. Our school office staff can help parents who may be experiencing difficulties with submitting their applications online.

PLEASE PARK AND STRIDE

There must be no 'drive-by' drop-offs or pick-ups at St Richard's. Instead, parents who drive to school must park safely and considerately and present themselves on foot to drop off and pick up their child. The plastic figures outside school and the yellow zigzag lines should be a reminder to all drivers that extreme caution must be exercised when driving anywhere near our school. We invite traffic enforcement officers to school on a regular basis to help keep all our pupils safe.
