KEY STAGE TWO LEAGUE TABLE SUCCESS

Last week, the government published Key Stage 2 performance tables for all schools for last academic year. We are delighted to announce that, of the 170 primary schools who make up the table for Manchester local authority, St Richard's was:

2nd for the average score in Maths.
3rd for the average score in Reading.
6th for the percentage of pupils attaining the higher standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.
9th for the percentage of pupils attaining the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.

This is a **FANTASTIC** achievement and one which we are all very proud of. This has all been made possible by our hard-working and dedicated teachers and TAs. Mr Keyworth, Mrs Toal and our Year 6 teachers are especially pleased with the achievements of our pupils last year, and we also thank our parents for their continued support in their children's success.

Manchester City Council will fund Free School Meal (FSM) vouchers over the school holiday periods this Christmas. Payments of £15.00 per week for every Free School Meal eligible pupil will be sent out to parents today, Thursday 18th December.
