Dear Parents/Carers,

Please find below an overview of our Key Stage 2 SATs results at St Richard's this year.

Our Key Stage 2 SATs results were, once again, EXCELLENT this year and our Year 6 pupils and their teaching staff did us all proud with their consistent effort and application in achieving these SUPERB test results:

<u>MATHEMATICS</u>	82% - Meeting expectations with 43% High Attaining (the national average at expected this year was 75%)
<u>READING</u>	89% - Meeting expectations with 44% High Attaining (the national average at expected this year was 75%)
<u>GPS</u>	87% - Meeting expectations with 61% High Attaining (the national average at expected this year was 74%)
<u>WRITING</u>	80% - Meeting expectations with 20% High Attaining (the national average at expected this year was 73%)

Our Year 6 children meeting expectations in Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined is **74%**. This is a GREAT result, and is considerably higher than the national average this year which is 63%. 13% of our pupils achieved High Attaining in all three subjects.

For the Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check there was no pass mark for this test, made up of 25 marks.

86% of our Year 4 pupils scored either 24 or 25, with over half at 61% scoring full marks. A superb achievement!

We thought that you would like to know that our School's Average Multiplication Tables Check Mark was **23.8**, which is well-above the national average of 21.0.

79% of the children in Year 1 achieved the pass mark in the Phonics Screening Check and again their teachers are very pleased with their progress.

EYFS: Reception Good Level of Development (GLD) = 68%

I would like to thank all the class teachers, intervention teachers, teaching assistants and pupils for all their hard work and dedication in making these very pleasing whole-school results possible. And of course, the parents, for the continued support you give with your child's development and education.
